1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Universal Intervention and Development Organization (UNIDOR) is a South Sudanese Faith Base Organization found and registered on 22nd April 2004 .

The organization is legally registered in South Sudan with Relief and Rehabilitation (RRC) according to South Sudan NGOs Act 2016, Under registration number 182.

UNIDOR is also a member of other Network and forum include South Sudan NGOs forum, Global Network for Civil Society and Disaster Reduction (GNDR) charter for Change (C4C) NEAR NETWORK, Local Response Pull Fund (LRPF) ,in term of working clusters UNIDOR is a member of Health, Nutrition Child Protection, Education, WASH and FSL clusters in which UNIDOR is a member of (Strategic Advisory Group -SAG) UNIDOR is a multisectoral Implemented organization as you will see details of our thematic below.

The Organization have clear Leadership structure , the higher organ is the board of Director (BoD) which comprise of seven technical members coming from different professional background , at the Organization level we have the senior management Team (SMT) whose roles is to monitor or supervised the organization daily activities , this body is the supreme in term of organization leadership level , the third layer of leadership is the middle Management team (MMT) which comprised of the Head of Programme , Director for Operation, Human Resource and Personnel Manager (HRM) , all Programme and Support Managers include Field base Managers , this group is mandate to meet Quarterly to discuss and review the Quarter achievement, challenge and future plan on the improvement.

1.1. ABOUT UNIDOR LOCALIZATION WORK EXPERIENCE

Universal Intervention and Development organization (UNIDOR) is an active member of Localization in the country under South Sudan Joint Response (SSJR) a project funded by Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA in the Netherlands through 14 Dutch Relief Alliance (DRA).

Supporting protracted crisis country South Sudan is part of those protracted crisis country, this project was hosted by Save the child Internation (SCI) from 2018 to 2023 and in 2024 to 2026 the Consortium is lead by Help a Child (HAC) International a member of DRA alliance in this consortium we have seven International NGOs who are lead of each consortium members on the project location.

Here are the INGOs as part of Alliance, Save the Children International, Plan International, War Child Holland International, Tearfund International, CARE International ,Help a Child Internation , Zoa/Dorcas Holland International , whereas the National partners in the consortium are,ACROSS, UNIDOR, SAADO, WOCO ,ADA, CH, CEF and WDG from 2024 Local partners increased from seven to nine (9) in this consortium UNIDOR is holding two key position, the Co-lead for Localization representing South Sudan and Local Advisory Group (LAG) a position reporting to the Board of Director representing South Sudan which report to the Board of Directors and board of Supervisors in Netherland.

In Unity State UNIDOR partner with CARE International, whereas Tear fund and CH are in partnership and we are all in Rubkona County , implementing Child Protection and Nutrition

2. THEMATIC AREA

1. **Health :** We implement Primary Health Care Programme with its component (Nutrition ,Maternal and child care, Expanded Programme on Immunization , Support of Boma health Initiative through county Health Department(CHD) and indeed we work with County Health Department every where we implement health and nutrition
2. **Nutrition:** currently UNIDOR is the lead nutrition implementing partner in Mayendit with support from UNICEF and WFP as well in Rubkona under South Sudan Joint Response in consortium with CARE International where UNIDOR implement Nutrition , in Mayendit we have established Nutrition Stabilization Centre (SC) , in addition through Save the children Support with R2G Project we support Community nutrition activities in Parieng that is in Ruweng Administrative areas
3. **WASH(Water and sanitation and Hygiene):** We implement both hard and software this mean we drilled boreholes with our drilling rig , flush boreholes which have blockage, we construct water yard for public used at community , promote community hygiene and sanitation , training water committee and pump Mechanic and pump care takers

4. **Protection:** We support both General protection which deal with population movement and

registration , we also support and implement Child Protection which deal with Family Tracing and Reunification (FTR) and psychosocial Support (PSS) ,Gender Base violent (GBV) campaign and awareness in addition to Mine Risk Education (MRE) awareness , the main funded partners include UNICEF, Save children supporting FTR and tracking records

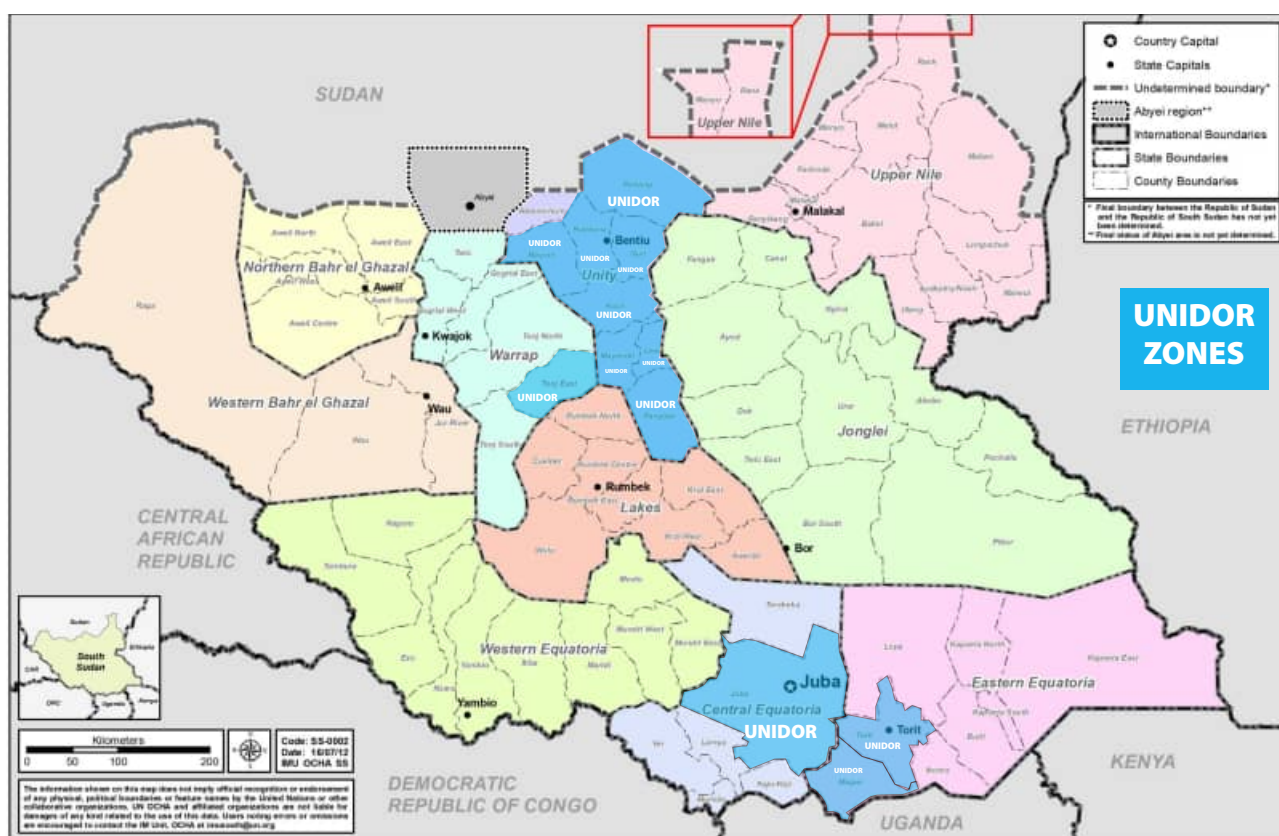
5. **Food Security and Livelihood (FSL)** we support farmers on agricultural activities , distribution of none Food Items (NFI) , shelters for Internally displaced Persons (IDPS) and Refugee , train community on fisheries , FOOD for Asset (FFA) the activities took place in Panyijiar particularly Nyal under Christian Aids support , for asset under support from World Food Programme (WFP) cover Nyal, Guit and Koch counties in Unity State
6. **Education:** we support both resilience and education in emergency where we construct temporally learning spaces (TLS) for children, the main supporter is Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC)
7. **Peace building and Conflict Resolution :** We implement different peace building projects from different partners under World Relief consortium we had RSRTF peace project implemented where UNIDOR was the only National Partners given the hotspot counties to carry out peace activities these are counties of Mayendit, Koch, Guit ,Rubkona and Mayom
8. **Climate Change and Adaptation :** South Sudan is among the country facing serious climate change the country have been facing natural disaster of flooding

Localization : UNIDOR is a co-lead for localization under the support of Dutch Relief Alliance (DRA) supporting of protracted Crisis here we have South Sudan Joint Response lead by Save the Children and Co-lead by UNIDOR at the same time UNIDOR is a Localization Advisory Group (LAG) which report to the Board of Directors in the Netherlands however from 2024 to 2026 the lead organization have change to Help a Child (HAC) International and UNIDOR maintain the same position

1. Challenge is part of the humanitarian phenomenon therefore the following are summary challenge faced by the organization
2. Operating in both Opposition and government control areas giving the current political journey in South Sudan this sometime result in refusal of humanitarian service delivery accessibility
3. Short term funding , some of the funding implemented are short term only few projects go for a year most project are six (6) Months
4. Lack of emergency fund to response to any emergency or acute crisis like the current flooding threat

unless one of the consortium lead from the International decided to give , under South Sudan Joint Response we have crisis Modifier with limited amount of fifty thousand US Dollars (\$ 50,000 USD per year

5. Deadly competition among the humanitarian over the humanitarian funding specially among the National Partners
6. Implementation of project during wet season even when there is no vehicle approved by the donor to facilitate the team field movement consider some location in South Sudan demand Land Cruiser
